

## Annuals

### Alyssum-Pastel Carpet

**Mix**--Lush carpets of small, pink, lavender and cream blooms are lovely planted in rock gardens, borders or containers. Plants spread to 10 inches and grow 4 to 6 inches tall.



### Coleus- Rainbow Mixed Colors

--Large, velvety leaves in many rich colors and combinations - predominantly red, green and yellow - make this a superb ornamental plant. Coleus develops its rich colors if shaded from afternoon sun. Plants grow 10 to 15 inches tall



### Dahlia-Unwin's Dwarf Mixed Colors

-- A blend of gorgeous shades of lavender, scarlet, crimson, bronze, salmon, apricot, orange and yellow. Blooms add new color to the late summer garden. Heat-resistant variety that grows 18 to 20 inches tall.



### Marigold-Crackerjack Mixed Colors

--A blend of bright shades of orange, gold, yellow and primrose. Huge flowers with gracefully overlapping petals bloom from midsummer to first frost. 2 - 3 feet.



### Marigold-Dwarf Bolero

--Half-Hardy Annual. An All-American Selection! The choice over several varieties of dwarf French double carnation flowered marigolds. Bi-color, bright mahogany red blossoms with gold markings are 2 inches across. Early and free blooming. 6 - 10 inches high.



### Pansy-Swiss Giants

**Mixed colors**--Large, velvety blooms dazzle with radiant colors of blue, violet, purple, mahogany, yellow and variations of stripes and blotches that look like smiling faces. Mildly fragrant. Flowers reach 3 inches or more across. Thrives in cool weather. 6 - 8 inches high.



### Petunia-Dwarf Bedding

**mixed colors**--Showy blooms in a range of bright, eye-catching colors. Blooms continuously from midsummer until frost and stays neat and low. 12 - 15 inches high.



### Snap Dragon-Fordhook

**Tall Mix**--Produces long spikes with many densely packed florets. Impressive in groups, bedding and edgings. Extremely heat tolerant. A magnificent performer! 30 - 36 inches high



### Verbena-Florist Mixed

**Colors**-- Clusters of dainty blossoms with a long blooming season make this a charming old-fashioned flower. Showy blooms, ranging from deep violet through lavender, red, pink, cream and white, flower freely on spreading compact plants. 6 - 8 inches high.



### Zinnia- Giant Double

**Enchantress**--Magnificent, large, dahlia-flowered blossoms in a rich, enchanting pink color on strong, tall plants. Blooms freely from mid-summer until frost. Easy to grow. 2 1/2 - 3 feet high.



### Zinnia-Giants of California Mixed

**Colors**--A favorite mix of large, showy, dahlia-flowered blooms in a variety of brilliant colors. Blooms from mid-summer until frost. 2 1/2 - 3 feet high



## Perennials

### Canterbury Bells-- Calycan Mixed Colors--

The blossom colors range from white through various pinks and mauves to deep-purple and even blue. 24 to 30 inches high.



### Carnation-Chabaud Giant Mixed Colors--

Large flowers with a delightful, spicy, clove-like fragrance have blooms in shades of crimson, red, rose, pink, yellow and white. Prized for its long season of bloom. 18 to 20 inches tall.



**Chinese Lantern--**"Chinese Lanterns" accurately describes the brilliant orange-red paper-like husks which enclose the berry. Cut the "Lanterns" for drying as soon as they have turned full color and prior to frost arriving in the fall. 24 - 30 inches high



**Chrysanthemum-Robinson Red--** Pure red to magenta colored 2.5" blooms . Makes a great cut flower too! The flowers are set above the fern-like foliage on very sturdy, straight stems that prolong the blooms' life in the vase and also serve as a solid foundation for the butterflies and bees visit. Blooms last up to 2 weeks.



**Columbine-McKana  
Giants Mixed Colors--**A graceful, classic flower with large, showy, spurred blooms in a wide range of colors including bi-colors. Expect the delicate-looking blooms in the spring. Attractive, blue-green foliage stays in neat clumps. 24 to 30 inches tall.



**Echinacea--**Perennial and drought resistant. Showy, dark, cone-shaped centers stand out inside the purple petals. Sometimes referred to as the "Purple Prairie Wildflower". Grows 30 to 42 inches high.



**Johnny Jump Up--**Gorgeous, miniature, pansy-like flowers in a combination of lavender, violet and canary yellow. 6 - 10 inches high.



**Painted Daisy-Mixed  
Colors--**Large flowers in brilliant shades of rose and scarlet with small, yellow centers bloom on long stems. Plants have feathery foliage. For best effect, group three to six plant as accents among annuals. 24 to 30 inches high.



**Shasta Daisy--**Pure-white, glistening flowers, 4 to 5 inches across with butter-yellow centers. Each plant sends up dozens of tall, sturdy stems from a clean, dark-green, bushy plant. Blooms appear the second season. 24 to 30 inches high.



**Sweet William-Double  
Flowered Mixed Colors--** Brilliant, old-fashioned biennials feature sweetly-scented flowers in combinations of pinks, reds and white. Each stem forms a mini-bouquet of small, fringed, double blooms. 18 inches tall.



**Viola-Cornuta Mixed  
Colors--**Charming, small flowers in jewel-like shades of scarlet, yellow, apricot, blue, violet and white. This "Tufted Pansy" blooms profusely over a long period and withstands heat and cold better than ordinary Pansies. 6 - 8 inches high.
